

# Homelearning Menu up to 08.06.19

## reading

Choose 3 important events from the book you are reading/ have already read and explain how you would have handled them differently to the characters in the story. Explain how it may have changed the outcome of the story in either a small or major way.

Place yourself in the shoes of one of the characters you have just read about and write a diary entry of a key moment from the story.

Try to choose a moment in the story in which the character has plenty of interaction and emotion to share in a diary entry. Your diary entry should be around a page in length and contain information you learnt from the book when the character was in that specific place and time. Remember when you are writing a diary entry you are writing it from first person perspective. It is usually but not always written in present tense.

Write about how it would change the story of the book you are actually reading or you have already read if the main character had made a different decision earlier in the story.

Pick the most important word/line/image/object/event from one chapter of your book and explain why you chose it. Be sure to support all analysis with examples

Have the character that most interests you write their autobiography of the time before, during, or after the story occurs.

After reading your book, create a Before/After list to compare the ways in which characters or towns have changed over the course of the story.

## writing

Write a poem about any topic that interests you. Then draw an illustration that matches your poem.

What alternative words can you use for went?

## MATHS



Draw and name as many shapes in your house as you can. Say where the shape can be found. For example, circle, found on top of a tin of Baked Beans. Draw the shapes, and write down their properties.

Janine owns a catering service company. She was hired to cater for the mayor's 50<sup>th</sup> birthday.

For the appetizers, she needs to make 750 mini meat pies. She divided her crew into 3 teams. If the first team made 235, and the second made 275, how many pies should the third team make?

For the first main dish, they were asked to cook steak. If the third and second team cooked 240 plates of steak, and the first team cooked 75 plates less than what the second and third team made, how many steaks did they cook altogether?

For the second main course, they made fish fillets for the 320 people at the party. The first team made 189 pieces, the second team made 131 pieces and the third team made 180 pieces, how many pieces were made altogether?



The next food item she has to prepare is soup. She needs 280 cups of mushroom soup. If the first team made 90 cups in 60 minutes, and the third team made 70 cups in 90 minutes, how many cups should the second team prepare in order to meet the required amount of soup?
